During the last years Joonas has grown MeetingPackage internationally and raised more than 4m USD in funding. AMIRA won AmCham award for project of the year for 2023 and several Intel awards for AI ML potential and is actively trying to integrate artificial intelligence technologies to fight AMR even better. Even before the MVP was finished it was purchased by one of the biggest hospitals in Bulgaria, with several other hospitals being on the verge of signing the preliminary contracts.
